We are an East Lothian based sports recycling programme run by Active Schools East Lothian. We collect new / no longer used sports equipment and redistribute it back into our local communities. It is important to us to get more young people active, reduce waste and encourage a more sustainable world.

## HOW WE OPERATE

- We accept donations at any of our drop off points located in all enjoyable leisure facilities and High Schools throughout East Lothian.
- All equipment is screened to ensure it is safe for use and then distributed to our various equipment banks for young people to access.
- Any young person can access any of our equipment banks to pick up the equipment they need free of charge. They can also swap outgrown kit/equipment in exchange for the next size required.
